



# Crazy Eight

## What is it?

The Crazy Eight is based on the classic 70's Tycobrahe Octavia circuit. An Octavia is an effect that produces an octave up sound with a sort of ring modulator flavor and in this case, a ton of thick fuzz as well. You've heard it on countless classic recordings from Jimi Hendrix to Jeff Beck.

## How does it work?

Check to see if your Crazy Eight came with a 9 Volt battery. If for some reason it didn't, make sure to use an alkaline battery or just use the negative tip DC power jack.

At first glance the controls may not seem to make much sense. Here's a breakdown of what they do...

**Left Mystery Knob** = Volume

**Right Mystery Knob** = Intensity

**Play** = Turns the effect on

**Insanity** = Red light is off: Fuzz. Red light is on: Fuzz and Octavia

**Enter** = You plug your guitar into this

**Exit** = Well, just guess...

**????** = 9 volt power supply (Use only a Boss PSA 120 style adaptor)

You hear the octave up sound best while playing single notes around and above the 12th fret. Also, try running the Crazy Eight in front of an overdrive box or a distorted amp and you'll get a cool kind of instant feedback so you can shred the National Anthem like it was 1969.

## What if it breaks?

All Tortuga Effects have a **Three Year Warranty**. I want you to be confident in the fact that your pedal will always work, so if you have any problems with it ("problems" do not include dropping it, backing over it with your truck or dropping it and backing over it with your truck) please contact an authorized Tortuga Effects dealer or just contact me directly and I'll get it taken care of.
